- Written Statement of your Philosophy of Education
- Current Resume
- Three (3) Current Letters of Recommendation
- Copies of Official Transcripts
- Copy of Arizona Superintendent Certificate

All materials submitted, as part of the application process, will remain confidential to the extent of the law, including any closed review sessions of the Governing Board. Once applications have been reviewed and screened, those selected will participate in interviews and a community forum.

SALARY & BENEFITS

Salary and benefits include a performance plan as prescribed by Arizona State Law. The employment term of contract will be as permissible by Arizona State Law. Final salary for the successful candidate will be negotiated and determined based upon proven experience, qualifications, and ability to meet criteria established by the Governing Board.
